A short **panoramic drive** through the city of **Alicante** reveals some of its better-known landmarks.

Watch for the **Paseo de la Explanada de España** -- a mosaic marble avenue reminiscent of sea waves -- and Luceros Square, where an impressive fountain dominates with a series of horse sculptures.

Head out of town on the road to **Elche** and its huge **park of palm trees**, which is quite unique at this latitude. This vast collection of palms is a designated **UNESCO World Heritage Site**, and the municipal park will introduce you to the world of plants and specifically to the palms of the area.

Don't miss the **Huerto del Cura** -- an exotic garden that contains specimens of rare varieties of palm. The garden boasts great botanical diversity and is the ideal place to stroll around and see its luxuriant plants. The fountains and the main lake placed right at the heart of the park are inspired by Arabian architectural styles, since this area was occupied for centuries by the Muslims. Enjoy a **tasting of local specialties** straight from the garden, followed by some **free time** to admire the park on your own. Then, head back to Alicante and the ship.

You will cross the center of town en route to the **Castle of Santa Barbara**, an aging fortress built in the 16th century. Visit the bestpreserved areas, such as the Main Tower (Torre del Homenaje) and the Englishmen's bastions.

From 500 feet above sea level, take in the beautiful view of the city, the bay and your ship. Inside the castle, admire some interesting Iberian archeological findings, which demonstrate that people lived there even before the arrival of the Romans.

Drive down the city's main boulevard -- the **Explanada de España**. Walk with your guide to enter the **Old Town**, which is closed to vehicles **Town Hall Square** and the Town Hall itself will surprise you with its delicate lines and Baroque style.

The Cathedral of Alicante, better known as the Church of San Nicolás de Bari, comes with an impressive façade that is one of the finest remaining examples of Spanish religious Baroque.

Step inside the **Museo de Fogueres**, which features photos and sculptures of plaster and papier mâché, depicting the different periods of the region's history.

Enjoy some **free time** to stroll in the city and perhaps try a *horchata* -- the traditional local drink made from tiger nut (earth almond) -before you return to the ship.

All about the archaeological aspect of Alicante, this tour begins with a **panoramic drive** to the MARQ Museum. Here, an expert curator guide leads you through the collections. The MARQ is an archaeology museum dedicated to displaying its collection in classified and cataloged order. It is also a brilliant introduction to the various methods and techniques of preservation and restoration in the field of archaeology. These are explained in three galleries -- Field Archaeology, Urban Archaeology and Underwater Archaeology. Dioramas, audiovisual presentations, and interactive exhibits provide visitors with a detailed insight into how archaeologists unveil the past. The information is displayed in an attractive and didactic way.

A walking tour through the city center brings you to the Fogueres Museum. This facility highlights the many celebrations and festivals held in Alicante each year, so it's all about fun and fiestas!

Return to the ship having experienced an extraordinary contrast in subject matter in each of the two museums.

# CANELOBRE CAVES & ALICANTE

Leaving the port area of Alicante, you will discover that, despite the small matter of the Mediterranean Sea, the city of Alicante is historically and economically more in step with North Africa than with Spain.

A walking tour leads you through Alicante's charming Old Town, located at the foot of the imposing castle.

Next, you'll drive to **Busot** to visit the **Canelobre Caves** -- a heritage site of the Valencian Autonomous Region. Within the cave is one of the highest vaulted ceilings of Spain -- about 210 feet tall -- like that of a cathedral. Admire the strange and beautiful natural works of art, including Medusa, the *candelabros* (from which the name of the caves derives) and a multitude of spectacular forms.

Returning to Alicante, relax during a brief **panoramic drive** as you catch a glimpse of this bustling Mediterranean city and head back to the ship.

#### **ENCHANTING ELCHE**



Duration: Approximately 4½ hours Departs at 10:00 am Price: Adult \$79.95; Child \$59.95

The town of **Elche**, with its **palm tree forest**, boasts the highest concentration of palms in all of Europe. They number between 200,000 and 300,000, and the singular beauty of the **Palmeral of Elche** has earned the distinction of being a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. Botanists believe that the Phoenicians planted this palm forest and that date palms have flourished in Elche for more than 2,000 years. The municipal park will introduce you to the world of palms and the flora of the area. Admire the abundant variety of Mediterranean species.

Visit the Baroque-style **Basilica of St Mary**, which houses the image of the city's patron saint.

The Huerto del Cura is an exotic garden that contains specimens of rare varieties of palm trees -- its great botanical diversity makes it the ideal place to stroll around and admire its luxuriant plants. The fountains and the main lake, placed right at the heart of the park, are all inspired by Arabian architectural styles. This area was occupied for centuries by the Muslims.

Retail therapy alert: don't miss shopping at the **Pikolinos Store** -- the retail side of a **shoe factory** created in 1987. It sells more than 1.6 million pairs of shoes annually on five continents. This factory has gone from humble beginnings to being a leader in the shoemaking sector. Its brands are nationally and internationally famous, and recently, it was voted the best company in the Valencia Province.

#### **GUADALEST**



Duration: Approximately 4<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> hours Departs at 10:15 am Price: Adult \$89.95; Child \$69.95

The inland town of **Guadalest** is a fascinating example of an **Islamic fortified town**. To this day, it remains relatively unchanged from how it would have looked when the Moors occupied it hundreds of years ago.

The oldest part of the town is accessible only **on** foot through a tunnel cut into the rock.

From the main square, climb a flight of **150 steps**, which leads up to the **ruined castle**.

The village provides excellent **shopping** opportunities -- from local craft products to diverse articles from all over the world.

#### Notes:

The road to the fortified town is steep and winding. Guests prone to motion sickness should consider this before booking and/or take appropriate medication. Not advisable for guests with mobility limitations.

#### MEDIEVAL ALICANTE WITH A HISTORY EXPERT



Duration: Approximately 6 hours Departs at 10:00 am Price: Adult \$109.95; Child \$79.95

Just 800-900 years ago, **Alicante** demarcated the frontier between the Arabs and the Christians and later between the Christian kingdoms. Its history is long and fascinating, and it's a story that deserves to be properly told, so a local history expert will guide you through the highlights today. Immerse yourself in the ancient streets, surrounded by age-old houses and medieval doors, to learn how its inhabitants lived, loved and defended themselves.

Within Alicante's **Old Town**, narrow streets and small squares contrast sharply with the castles built by feudal lords throughout southern Spain. Alicante boasts many such landmarks, including the original Castillo de Villena, Village Historica and Castillo de Biar, where history comes to life. The castles of Vinalopó are a National Monument.

Explore the **Castillo de Biar** -- this castle features an extraordinary 12th-century dome. Perched on a rocky hillside 2,460 feet above sea level, it is a Muslim-era fort that has retained its intriguing double-wall enclosure.

Return to the ship in Alicante a little more knowledgeable about this amazing region.

#### Notes:

Participants must walk about three miles. Wear comfortable walking shoes. Suitable only for the physically fit. Not advisable for guests using a wheelchair or for those with mobility limitations. Use of an audio headset (included) will enhance your tour experience. Tour does not operate on Mondays.

#### **NOVELDA & WINE TASTING**



Duration: Approximately 4<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> hours Departs at 10:15 am Price: Adult \$89.95; Child \$69.95

Drive towards **Novelda** in the province of Alicante. Novelda is located in the southern part of the wider region of Valencia and is famous for its vineyards. The city shares its borders with Elda and Petrel on the northern provincial border.

You will head to the Sanctuary of Santa Magdalena and the adjacent remains of the La Mola Castle, both located on the same hill. The sanctuary is a religious building and part of a project undertaken by Novelda-based engineer, José Sala. His design is in the Catalan Modernist style, of which he was a disciple. Take photos to fully appreciate these impressive monuments.

Next up is **Heretat de Cesilia** -- one of the region's better-known wine cellars. The origin of the winery and its products lies in the exemplary Casa Cesilia wines first produced by the Marquis de Romana in 1707. During your visit, your guide will explain the 18th-century Labor House and will introduce you to the vineyards and the modern-day winery. Enjoy a pleasant **wine-tasting** session and, if you like, browse for a bottle to take back home.

#### **SHOPPING WITH A CHEF**

Alicante's **Market Square** beckons foodies and gourmands to explore with a local chef. Fish,

seafood, oysters, and other produce typical of the area are piled high on the stalls. Your chefguide from a nearby restaurant will explain the products and how they're used specifically in this region. Watch for salaçones -- the dried and salted fish that is a favorite with the people of the province. The market itself is a fascinating hub of commerce and activity -- an excellent venue for people-watching.

Next, visit a typical **Spanish restaurant** to taste the products that you saw at the market. This is a delicious introduction to Alicante and the Valencia Region.

You're in the vicinity of the bullring, the Plaza de Luceros and the Old Town. Keep an eye out for some of these highlights as you travel.

Enjoy a **panoramic drive through Barcelona** -- a light introduction to this marvelous city (time and traffic permitting) -- before you head out of town.

Ride by coach to the **Montserrat Mountain Ridge**, six miles long, three miles wide and 4,050 feet tall. The irregular peaks of Catalonia's most famous mountain are visible from miles around. Montserrat is a cultural, religious and natural landmark. Legend says that shepherds found a statue of a black Virgin Mary on Montserrat. When they tried to move her, the cart got stuck, which they took as a sign to she should stay on the mountain. So this peculiar mountain range is now the site of the monastery where people come to worship La Moreneta -- the black Madonna who is the patron-virgin of Catalonia. You will visit the **Benedictine Monastery**, founded in the 11th century, set on a natural platform at 2,380 feet above sea level. The Benedictine community now numbers 80 monks, and has served the shrine for almost a thousand years, dedicated to a life of prayer, work and welcoming pilgrims. Montserrat is also home to the Escolans -- the oldest boys' choir in Europe.

Enjoy a **panoramic drive through Barcelona** -- a light introduction to this marvelous city (time and traffic permitting) -- before you head out of town.

Ride by coach to the **Montserrat Mountain Ridge**, six miles long, three miles wide and 4,050 feet tall. The irregular peaks of Catalonia's most famous mountain are visible from miles around. Montserrat is a cultural, religious and natural landmark. Legend says that shepherds found a statue of a black Virgin Mary on Montserrat. When they tried to move her, the cart got stuck, which they took as a sign to she should stay on the mountain. So this peculiar mountain range is now the site of the

monastery where people come to worship La Moreneta -- the black Madonna who is the patron-virgin of Catalonia.

You will visit the **Benedictine Monastery**, founded in the 11th century, set on a natural platform at 2,380 feet above sea level. The Benedictine community now numbers 80 monks, and has served the shrine for almost a thousand years, dedicated to a life of prayer, work and welcoming pilgrims. Montserrat is also home to the Escolans -- the oldest boys' choir in Europe.

#### Notes:

Travel time to Montserrat is approximately one hour each way. Modest attire is required for visiting churches or cathedrals; knees, shoulders and midriffs must be covered; shorts are not allowed. Be prepared for long lines at the monastery for viewing the Black Virgin. Tour timing may preclude viewing the Virgin if the lines are extremely long. Corsica is an island of rocky outcroppings and sandy beaches, with secret trails that lead inland over fields and through lazy villages. In Ajaccio, visit Napoleon Bonaparte's house, containing original furniture of Corsica's most famous son. Buy a wedge of tangy cheese at the market, and in the mountains, delight in the scent of sunwarmed thyme.

#### A TASTE OF CORSICA

Board your motor coach at the pier for a **panoramic drive** inland to discover a landscape covered with *macchia* -- the island's fragrant chaparral vegetation.

Visit the **essential oil distillery** at Ocana, where herbs and flowers are pressed into essential oils for aromatherapy or for use in perfumes.

Corsica also has approximately 24,710 acres of vines under cultivation and a stop at a local **vineyard** means you are sure to enjoy a **taste** of at least one of the varietals.

Try some **nougat** as well. This is a classic French-Corsican confection famed throughout



the Mediterranean. Your visit to the nougat factory allows you to follow every step of the production.

Notes:

Corkage policy: Wine purchased on this tour is exempt from the on-board corkage fee (offer limited to one bottle of wine per person). If closures require a change to the itinerary, you may sample honey instead of nougat.

#### AJACCIO SIGHTS

Ajaccio is the largest town in Corsica and the birthplace of Napoleon Bonaparte. Begin your tour with a drive along the Route des Sanguinaires, passing a series of white sand beaches en route to Punta Della Parata. Take in the superb views of the Iles Sanguinaires -- the four red granite islets that dominate the entrance to the Golfe d'Ajaccio.

Heading back into town you will travel down the Cours Napoleon and pass the Place de Gaulle with its immense bronze monument to Napoleon and his brothers. Continue past the

former English Quarter and the Assemblée Régionale to **Place Austerlitz**, where Bonaparte played as a child. The square is dominated by an immense monument to Napoleon, set atop a huge pedestal inscribed with the names of his battles.

Disembark here to explore the **Old Town** on a guided **walk**. Step inside the Venetian-style **Baroque cathedral**, which the locals refer to as A Madonuccia. Its interior includes the font where the future emperor was baptized, a marble altar dating from 1811, and Delacroix's painting, *La Vierge au Sacre Coeur*.

You will walk past the Casa Bonaparte, where the Little Emperor was born in 1769, and view the Roman-style statue of Napoleon as First Consul in the **Place Foch**. Pass the Town Hall, situated just behind the Market Square, and return to the ship on foot.

#### Notes:

Inside church visit(s) may not be possible if religious services are being held or if precluded by time constraints. You cannot leave any personal effects on the coach. Participants who do not wish to participate in the walk can ride back to pier by coach.

#### CARGESE GREEK VILLAGE

Corsica is a beautiful island off the Mediterranean coast of France. It offers sandy beaches, rugged coastline, mountains, wild countryside, fascinating towns and villages. Kallisté -- the most beautiful -- was what the ancient Greeks called Corsica, and the compliment holds as true today as ever. In few corners of the Mediterranean will you find water as transparent, sand as soft and white, and weather so dependably warm and sunny; and nowhere else has seascapes as dramatic as the red porphyry Calanches of the west coast, and the striated white cliffs in the far south.

This outing offers a **panoramic drive** from Ajaccio to San Bastiano Pass, with superb views of the Gulf of Ajaccio along the way. You will follow the coastal route along the sandy beachfront of the Gulf of Sagone. The road takes you through little summer resorts before arriving in the ancient Greek village of Cargese, sitting high above a deep blue bay.

Follow your guide **on foot** through winding, flower-filled lanes, dripping with fig trees, bougainvillea and palm trees, and learn about the origins of the village, when 730 Greek settlers from the southern Peloponnese landed in Corsica in 1676. You will visit the **two churches**, one Catholic and one Orthodox -- a reminder of the old antagonism between the two cultures.

Drive back along the same road and stop on the way for a **taste of local products** before returning to Ajaccio.

The village of Cargèse features a very steep uphill walk with many steps and cobblestones.

Walk to Castel Sant Angelo, crossing the River Tiber to reach **Piazza Navona**. Wander along **Via dei Coronari**, famous for its little shops full of art and antiques. See the Pantheon from the outside and visit the **Trevi Fountain**. Toss a coin in -- according to tradition, this will ensure your return to Rome.

Taste two different types of **pizza** from a nearby vendor. Pass Venice Square and glimpse the ruins of the Roman Forum -- once the heart of the ancient city. At a **local restaurant**, savor a **wine-tasting** session accompanied by Italian charcuterie.

View the Colosseum from the outside, with time to snap some excellent photos before returning to the ship by coach.

This tour is available only to guests whose cruise does not begin or end in Civitavecchia. Not advisable for guests using a wheelchair. Explore the richest storehouse of art in the entire world at the **Vatican Museums**. As you walk through one room after another in the Vatican, you will be awed by the size and scope of the incredible collections displayed in the Tapestry and Geographical Maps Galleries, and the Candelabra Gallery.

Reach the **Sistine Chapel**, perhaps the most famous church in the world, which holds a priceless collection of masterpieces by Botticelli, Signorelli, Perugino, and, of course, *Genesis* and *The Last Judgment* by Michelangelo Buonarroti, who spent four grueling years painting 10,000 square feet of the chapel's ceiling. Enter the vast expanse of **St Peter's Square**, which can hold more than 300,000 people.

Pass through the embracing arms of Bernini's colonnade and enjoy outside views of St Peter's Basilica, Christendom's largest church.

Please note that all major monuments in Rome are bound to be overcrowded with long lines. Due to the expected overcrowding (regular tourists + pilgrims) the traffic conditions of Rome might be affected as well.

The order of the tour may be reversed or altered depending on traffic or local conditions.

Depending upon the number of people in the Basilica, it may be closed for security reasons without previous notice. These safety precautions are beyond the control of the local tour operator.

If your guide determines that the wait to enter St Peter's is longer than 45 minutes, you will forgo the inside visit and your guide will provide you with a full explanation and description while outside. More time for shopping or exploring independently will be substituted. Tour groups are not allowed inside St Peter's Basilica during religious services; however, entry will be allowed on an individual basis to view the interior quietly and reverently. In case the Basilica should be closed for security reasons or any unexpected event your guide will provide a full explanation from outside and free time for photos and shopping will be given.

### A WALK THROUGH OLD BARI

The Greeks, Romans, Byzantines, and Normans all took advantage of Bari's strategic location, and the Crusaders often sailed from Bari in the Middle Ages. Evidence of this illustrious past can be seen in the **Old Town** -- Bari Vecchia.

Among its winding streets are several breathtaking medieval structures, including the **Basilica of St Nicolas** (1087), named for Bari's patron saint. Enter this lovely Romanesque church, whose treasures include the remains of the revered saint, carved stone doorways, an elaborate stone canopy over the altar, and a 900-year-old marble bishop's throne.

During your **walking tour**, take in outside views of the Norman-Suevian castle built during the reign of Frederick II (1131) and the Cathedral of



Saint Sabin. You might catch sight of women preparing traditional Apulian pasta called *orecchiette* (little ears), totally by hand and using the edge of a knife.

At Ferrarese Square, enjoy some **free time** to purchase a gelato or an Italian coffee (at your own expense) before transferring back to the port.

Whitewashed buildings with grey roofs lend the village a magical atmosphere, and more than 1,400 cone-shaped buildings known as trulli dot the cobblestone streets and hillsides. Walk through the town and learn about its history, which began in the Bronze Age. Thousands of years ago, residents built their homes out of the only material available -- limestone. Made without mortar, they could easily be torn down and rebuilt. Many of the trulli boast roofs adorned with painted symbols, such as a cross or a heart pierced by an arrow, to bring luck to the house. The Old Town alone boasts about 1,000 dwellings lining the winding streets and climbing the hillside -- the views from the top are aweinspiring.

Visit the much newer **Church of Saint Anthony**, built in 1927.

Your guide will lead you to a **rustic farmhouse** called a *masseria*, where you can relax with a glass of local **wine** and a golden slice of **Apulian focaccia**. This regional specialty is topped with cherry tomatoes and oregano.

Visit the **Maritime Museum** to learn of Perast's long and lasting association with the sea.

The catamaran offers panoramic viewing of the islet which, according to legend, was created over the centuries by seamen who kept an ancient oath -- returning from each successful voyage, they laid a rock in the bay, and, over time, the islet gradually emerged from the sea.

Watch for the Porto Montenegro Marina -- the first luxury marina on the Adriatic. Step ashore at the **Movida Restaurant & Lounge Club** at the Solila Marina, where you can swim at beautiful **Solila Beach** or simply relax on a sunbed.

Finally, board a motorcoach for a pleasant drive back to the port.

#### Notes:

Wear your swimsuit under your clothing; bring a towel, reef-safe/biodegradable sunscreen, light clothing to act as a full cover-up for further protection from the sun, and a hat. Swim at your own risk. Adriatic beaches are typically pebble beaches rather than sand.

#### VRMAC NATURE PARK BY BUGGY

Fabulous scenery entices visitors to this magical part of the planet. On Boka Bay, the **magnificent Mt Vrmac** dominates, beckoning the adventurous to scale its 2,493-foot height **by buggy**.

Start out from the coast, heading inland and upward on this challenging ascent. The prize is the ultimate 360-degree views over the bay and its most beautiful spots.

Within Vrmac Nature Park, there are many

viewpoints along the old road to stop and take photos. Landscape and history are inextricably linked here. See the remains of Austro-Hungarian fortresses, as well as many nature paths.

The ride back down is equally thrilling.

No one introduced **Athens** to the world as elegantly as Milton did -- "Athens, the eye of Greece, mother of arts and eloquence." Your visit today will begin with the most famous temple of the Ancient City -- the **Parthenon** -dedicated to Athena, the patron goddess of Athens. Walking up a winding path towards the **Acropolis**, you will pass through the Propylaea and see the Erechtheum temple and the Porch of the Caryatids in the distance. Reinforced by the hand of man, the natural fortress of the Acropolis stands 230 feet above the city. You cannot help but be in awe of the view below.

Continue towards Constitution Square and view the former Royal Palace. At the latter, the Evzones National Guard keeps watch, in their colorful traditional costume, over the Tomb of the Unknown Warrior. See the allmarble Olympic Stadium built for the modern Olympic Games in 1896. Pass by the National Gardens and drive along University Street, whose numerous neo-Classical buildings include the University and the Library.

You will stop for photos at the foot of the Acropolis. The Agora (gathering place) in Athens was once a private housing area. In the 6th century BC, Peisistratus reorganized it, removing the residences and closing the wells. The Agora then became the center of the Athenian government.

The **Old Town** area of Athens, known as the **Plaka**, awaits you. Here, you will enjoy a traditional **lunch** before transferring to the airport.

Terrain includes even and uneven surfaces, cobblestones, inclines, and steps. Wear comfortable non-skid walking shoes.
